

ADDENDUM TO AUTHOR AGREEMENT: AI SUBSIDIARY AGGREGATION

(the "Addendum")

This Addendum is made between the entities listed in the table below, each a "Party", together the "Parties".

BACKGROUND

THIS ADDENDUM modifies the Author Agreement previously made between the Parties dated [REDACTED] (the "Original Agreement") in respect of the work entitled [REDACTED] (the "Work").

WHEREAS Cambridge now wishes to expand the rights granted to Cambridge by the Author under the Original Agreement to ensure that the Work can be included in the future AI-related aggregation opportunities described below.

IT IS NOW HEREBY AGREED BETWEEN THE PARTIES:

1 DEFINITION OF AI SUBSIDIARY AGGREGATION

1.1 For the purposes hereof, "AI Subsidiary Aggregation" shall mean a new type of subsidiary use where rights in the Work (in whole or in part) are granted to a third-party licensee by Cambridge in order to permit the licensee to include, excerpt or adapt the Work in an AI content aggregation engine or LLM (Large Language Model), for public or private distribution, including where that engine or LLM contains work published by both Cambridge and other publishers.

2 REMUNERATION FOR AI SUBSIDIARY AGGREGATION

2.1 Remuneration to the Author for use of the Work under an AI Subsidiary Aggregation licence shall be a royalty rate of 20% and paid on a case-by-case basis, allocated to the Author from (and where applicable, as a pro-rata share of) the Net Revenue derived from such licence.

3 MORAL RIGHTS

3.1 Nothing herein shall affect, reduce or amend the assertion of moral rights by the Author pursuant to the Original Agreement. Any AI Subsidiary Aggregation licensing will be conducted by Cambridge in compliance with such assertion and the Work shall be cited accordingly.

4 GENERAL

- 4.1 This Addendum to the Original Agreement shall come into effect on the Effective Date shown above.
- 4.2 The Addendum may be executed in any number of counterparts. However, it shall not become fully executed until each Party has executed and delivered its counterpart to Cambridge.
- 4.3 Other than as amended in this Addendum, all terms and conditions of the Original Agreement shall remain in full force.
- 4.4 Defined terms used in this Addendum shall have the meaning given in the Original Agreement.
